This stunning 9-day tour will offer you the opportunity to discover the treasures of Tuscany. Starting in Lucca, Tuscany's best-kept secret, discover its Renaissance walls, Romanesque churches, and medieval streets flanked by towers. See the Ponte del Diavolo (Devil's Bridge) and the nearby remains of the Gothic Line – the Germans' last defense during WWII. ## TOUR ITINERARY:

### DAY 1: PITTSBURGH - ROME

Arrive in time at Pittsburgh Airport to check in and board your international flight. Enjoy inflight meals and extra services. Overnight onboard

### DAY 2: ROME ARRIVAL - MONTECATINI TERME (-/-/D)

Your tour opens in the famous spa resort town of Montecatini Terme, nestled in the heart of the rolling hills of Tuscany. This evening, get to know your fellow travelers during a welcome dinner where regional foods and Italian wines kick off your adventure. Overnight in Montecatini Terme



### DAY 3: LUCCA - BORGO A MOZZANO - GOTNIC LINE (B/-/-)

Enjoy a guided tour of Lucca, Tuscany's best-kept secret. Discover Renaissance walls, Romanesque churches, and medieval streets flanked by towers. Explore on your own before setting off for Borgo a Mozzano. See the Ponte del Diavolo (Devil's Bridge) and the nearby remains of the Gothic Line – the Germans' last defense during WWII. Visit the Museum of Liberation and see authentic fortifications and bunkers. Make your way to a Tuscan winery and learn about the art of winemaking as you taste local varieties.

### DAY 4: FLORENCE (BY TRAIN) (B/-/-)

A cultural tour in Florence showcases the beautiful "Cradle of the Renaissance." Start with a visit to the Academy Gallery\* to see Michelangelo's sculpture of David. Join a local Florentine guide on foot and make your way through the city. At the Piazza del Duomo, see the impressive Cathedral of Santa Maria del Fiore and the gilded bronze doors of the Baptistery dedicated to St. John. Take the remainder of your time in Florence to explore this unparalleled city as you choose.

### DAY 5: MONTECATINI TERME (B/-/-)

Today, after breakfast, learn more about Montecatini's curative waters during a guided walking tour and visit to the historic Tettuccio Spa, known for the health benefits in its mineral waters. Afternoon at leisure or journey to Siena and embark on a walking tour through its narrow Gothic streets (optional), getting to know the local lifestyle in a contrada (neighborhood) whose community is centered around the colorful Palio horse race.

**DAY 6: PISA (B/-/D)**

Explore historic sites in the ancient maritime Republic of Pisa, including the Piazza dei Miracoli, or "Field of Miracles" (UNESCO). Keep your camera handy at the famous Leaning Tower of Pisa. Visit the Baptistery, the largest in Italy. This evening, travel to the quiet countryside to learn the secrets of traditional Tuscan cuisine. Partake in a cooking class, using local ingredients and culinary techniques that have been passed down for generations. Enjoy your freshly-prepared meal for dinner.

**DAY 7: MONTECATINI TERME (B/-/-)**

The day is yours to relax and experience the local flavor. Take this opportunity to shop at the local boutiques and dine at one of the many fine local restaurants. Or, perhaps you will choose an optional excursion to Cinque Terre with its rugged coastline dotted with terraced vineyards; explore this string of fishing villages nestled between the mountains and the Mediterranean.

**DAY 8: CHEESE FARM VISIT - SAN GIMIGNANO (B/-/D)**

At a nearby cheese farm, learn how the famous pecorino cheese is made before sampling it for yourself. Soak in breathtaking views as you travel to the hilltop village of San Gimignano, one of Tuscany's most picturesque places. Explore this enchanting medieval town, from its famous 14 towers to its magnificent vistas overlooking vineyards. Enjoy free time and perhaps indulge in some gelato. Later, attend a Tuscan feast of traditional cuisine and wines set in the countryside.

**DAY 9: ROME - PITTSBURGH (B/-/-)**

Your journey comes to a close today. Depart with many fond memories of Tuscany. After breakfast, you will be transferred to Rome International Airport to prepare for your flight back home.

## **Day 9 - Montecatini/Rome:**

**(B/-/-)**

After breakfast, meet your guide and driver and set off for Rome. Upon your arrival in Rome, transfer to your hotel for check-in where the rest of the afternoon is at leisure and yours to enjoy. Romans say that "Rome wasn't built in a day", nor can Rome be seen in a day. One could live in the Eternal City for years and still not see everything. It's hard to say what you'll find most breathtaking: Etruscan tombs, the Republican meeting rooms, imperial temples, early Christian churches, medieval bell towers, baroque basilicas or renaissance palaces. Tonight you are on your own for dinner. You will have no trouble finding local restaurants in this residential area of Rome. Just outside the hotel and around the corner are some lovely places where the locals meet to eat, have a glass of local wine and enjoy a dish of pasta. Ask your guide or the concierge at the hotel to make a recommendation, they are eager and pleased to help. Overnight at Roma Milton. (Breakfast)

## **Day 10 - Rome:**

**(B/-/-)**

After breakfast we will start exploring the magnificence of the eternal city. In the morning enjoy a guided tour of Imperial Rome, the Rome of the Caesars. Visit the Roman Forum, the most important archaeological area in the city and once the center of the public life; visit the Colosseum, the most famous monument of ancient Rome and an impressive testament to her past greatness. We enjoy lunch in a local family run trattoria to taste the flavors of the "Cucina Romana". After lunch

continue the tour of the Vatican Museums and the Sistine Chapel. The Vatican Museums and their immense wealth of art, resulting from centuries of papal collections, offer an extraordinary experience. Amongst others, see the great masterpieces of Michelangelo, "The Last Judgement" in the Sistine Chapel. End the tour visiting St. Peter's Basilica to admire the art treasures of the largest Roman Catholic Church in the world, including Michelangelo's Pietà (appropriate attire required no shorts or sleeveless tops). Your tour include entrance to the Roman Forum, Colosseum and Vatican Museum, we avoid lines with pre-assigned reservations. Enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure, where you can do some shopping or take a stroll on the Via Veneto. Tonight dinner is on your own; enjoy your last night in Rome. (Breakfast, Lunch)

## **Day 11 – Rome – PITTSBURGH**

**(B/-/-)**

After breakfast, say ciao to Rome, transfer to the airport for your return flight home.
